OTHER REGISTERABLE INTERESTS Following the adoption of a new Code of Conduct Councillors are now required to register other interests in addition to the Disclosable Pecuniary Interests outlined above. It is a requirement of the Code that Councillors register the following interests:

- a) any unpaid directorships
- b) any body of which you are a member or are in a position of general control or management and to which you are nominated or appointed by your authority
- c) any body
 - i. exercising functions of a public nature
 - ii. directed to charitable purposes or
 - iii. one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union)of which you are a member or in a position of general control or management.

The registration of Other Registerable Interests only applies to the Councillor themselves.

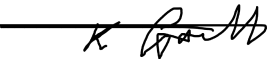
