This is delivered from our main offices in Chesterfield, Alfreton and Shirebrook. We have 16 outreaches that we attend each week over Chesterfield, Bolsover, Amber Valley and North East Derbyshire so that people can access our services locally and not have to travel too far. We also give telephone advice from 8:30-4pm each weekday. This service is invaluable to people who are on low income and struggling through the cost of living crisis. This works meets with the Trust's funding themes by preventing or reducing the impact of poverty and supporting marginalised groups and tackling inequality. We aim to use this funding to help people within the Warsop area. Giving people our support means they will then

Hi Jade,

We had a Vibrant Venue custodians meeting last night and the Scouts raised that as there will be no carnival this year then they are now trying to investigate ways to raise funds.

I advised that the parish council and the carnival committee are trying to investigate other opportunities for fundraising events and will keep them informed. The Carnival will be sending out some meeting date proposals shortly.

Vibrant will be running the rolo fund again in October and we wondered if the Parish Council would be interested in contributing to the RoLo fund on an annual basis.
