Summary Report from the Clerk – August and September 2026

- Warsop Parish News Autumn and Winter edition is in progress
- Planning for Remembrance 2026 is underway
- The Shake it off event was successful and raised over £650 for Warsop Carnival. Positive feedback has been received.
- We received one entry for the Sunflower competition. We will review this event for next year.
- Animal Therapy sessions – we have applied for funding from the Co-op but we have a small underspend from Shake it Off
- Winterfest 2026 stalls are now fully booked and planning is ongoing
- Halloween disco is postponed due to workload – potentially next year. We may do a small competition
- Liaison with NCC and County Councillor regarding road safety issues at schools within the parish
- The Pride in Place application for funding from MDC has been edited and resubmitted
- We have not received a date yet for commencement of building works at Lifespring
- The Clerk has ordered the 5 x free allocation of rock salt bags from Via EM for the Town Hall
- The new printer/scanner was delivered on 11th August
- Staff training is ongoing for Fire Warden, Martyn's Law and Risk Assessments
- Staff continue to scan historic Warsop News editions
- Staff assisted with the co-ordination of a petition(s) in the village regarding the potential closure of Burns Lane (575 signatures)
- The roofing works at the Shed were completed in August. There was a visit from Steve Yemm MP and Mayor Claire on Friday 7th August
- The Clerk will follow up soon with remaining schools in the Parish for Chambers visits/mock debates
